1. Joining the library

Who is eligible to join the library?

- All University Hospitals of Leicester (UHL) Staff
- Leicestershire Partnership Trust (LPT) Staff
- All Primary Care Staff in Leicestershire & Rutland
- Any medical, allied health practitioner (AHP) or nursing student at our local universities.

You can apply in person or using the form on our homepage.

2. Services and facilities

Where is the library?

UHL Libraries are located at all three hospitals; the General, Glenfield (within the Clinical Education Centres) and the Royal Infirmary (Victoria Building).

When are you open?

We are staffed from Monday to Friday (see the back of this leaflet for details), however 24hr access is available. Simply pay a £10 deposit for an access card which you can use in all three libraries.

How many books can I borrow?

Staff can borrow six items & students four items for up to 28 days. For any items we do not have we can apply for an **interlibrary loan** on your behalf from another library. (This service is for staff only).

Can I print, scan and photocopy?

We have free wifi, PC access and scanning facilities. We also provide printing and copying for a small charge.

What kind of help can I get from the library?

Training

The library provides training on topics including literature searching, using other electronic resources, RefWorks, critical appraisal, and writing for publication. They can be tailored to your needs and delivered to groups or individuals in the library or in your workplace. Book via Knowledgeshare.

Literature Searching

The library team can provide literature searches to support clinical practice as well as the development of guidelines, patient information, audit and research. Our online request form is at:

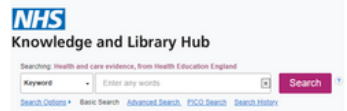
3. Resources (Links to resources can be found on our website)

Books & journals

Our collection consists of medical books and journals as well as our Time Out (leisure reading), wellbeing and patient information collections.

Online Databases

We provide access to a number of databases including Maudsley Prescribing Guidelines in Psychiatry, Cinahl, PsychInfo, Embase and British Nursing Index. They provide abstract and/or full text access to a range of journals, ebooks and other medical resources. These can either be accessed individually or they can be searched simultaneously via the Knowledge and Learning Services Hub.
