Services

Inter-library loans

Books and journals not available at the UHL and Learning Disability libraries can be obtained on your behalf through the inter library loan service.

Printing, Photocopying and Scanning

At UHL libraries printing, photocopying and scanning facilities are available. The Learning Disability library has photocopying and printing facilities.

Library Skills Training

The library provides training in internet searching, effective database searching (PsychInfo, Medline, CINAHL, Cochrane) and critical appraisal.

Literature Searching

We offer a full literature searching service. We can search for a single piece of information or undertake a detailed literature search to support clinical practice, the development of guidelines, patient information leaflets, audit and research.

Current Awareness

We can set up Table of Contents alerts for your favourite journals. This email service alerts you to the publication of new issues, gives you contents details and may allow you to link directly to the full-text of articles.
